

WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY

We, Golazo Cycling Limited (also referred to as “GC”), are committed to protecting the privacy and confidentiality of information provided by all users of this website. This privacy policy explains how we use and protect the information that you provide to us.

Consent: You can access most of the pages on our website without giving us your personal information. GC recognises the importance of protecting the privacy of personal information and no personal information is automatically collected. However, where you have the option to provide us with your personal information through our website, by submitting your personal information, you consent to our use of the information as set out in this privacy policy and in the privacy statements that appear on the forms through which you submit your personal information.

Use of information: Contact details of race entrants shall be passed to the UCI in order that invitations to the UCI Worlds Amateur Road Championships maybe issued. Contact details will also be passed to British Cycling as a condition of their support for Golazo Cycling events.

All personal information you provide us with or that we obtained is handled and processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act. You agree that the information provided to ChronoRace and ourselves may be retained and used to for marketing purposes relating to cycling and other events in the future. You agree to receive non telephone based marketing material from time to time.

By completing the online entry form, you will be included in our newsletter and report mailing list. This is an informative service, relating to our events and aimed at improving our customer service. Please send us an email if you wish to be removed from the mailing list.

Personal information is collected only when voluntarily submitted via registration or contact forms. We may collect certain non-personal information to optimize our web pages for your computer (i.e., the identity of your Internet browser, your operating system, your IP address and the domain name of your Internet service provider). We may use such non-personal information for internal purposes, including but not limited to improving the content of our websites.

GC may use personal information in aggregate form to improve our websites and in particular, more responsive to your needs. In those instances when we do collect personal information GC will notify you when we are collecting personal information and our intentions. For example, we may need to collect such information to provide you with event or product details.

The use of personal information is only for the purpose for which it is submitted unless we disclose other uses within this privacy policy or at the time of collection. Please remember that any information posted on bulletin boards is posted at your own risk, is public information and caution is advised when sharing information whilst considering the potential consequences.

Personal information may be disclosed in special circumstances where GC has reason to believe that doing so is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against anyone damaging, injuring, or interfering (intentionally or unintentionally) with GC’s rights, property, users, or anyone else who could be harmed by such activities. Also, GC may reveal information to the relevant authorities when we believe in good faith that the law requires it.

Data protection: GC maintains appropriate safeguards to ensure the security, integrity and privacy of personal information, and periodically reviews and updates security measures in line with current and developing technologies. Unfortunately, no data transmission over the Internet is guaranteed to be totally secure and whilst GC strives to protect your personal information, we cannot ensure or warranty the security of any information you may submit.

Third parties: GC occasionally engages in activities with clearly identified business partners and sponsors with whom personal information is jointly collected or shared. GC has established relationships with reputable business partners and sponsors that allow visitors to our website to link directly to their dedicated websites and some of these websites may be branded with Tour of Cambridgeshire logos; however, these websites are not operated or maintained by GC. These sites may collect personal information that may be shared with GC.
